

## Display Case Sections



### 1. Glass Module

The glass module is one of the main defining factors in your display case design. Assuming a standard 38" H display case, the traditional sizes of the glass modules are:

- (A) Extra View – features a 32" H glass display module;
- (B) Full View – features a 26" H glass display module;
- (C) Half View – features a 18" H glass display module; and,
- (D) Jewelry or Third View – features a 12" H glass display module.

### 2. Base

The base is the wood portion of the display case. The base size is determined by the style of display case selected. The base of the display case can be finished as per your desire in either solid finish colors or wood grain finishes.

### 3. Kick Base

The kick base is usually 4" – 6" H and finished in black to hide scuffs and kicks.

### 4. Extrusion

The extrusion is the metal finish surrounding the glass display module and at the corners of the base (when a low pressure laminate is used).
